

# Granny Squares Hat



Pattern #-M23053 MDO

Yarn-

Lion Brand® Mandala® Ombre

### **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

# **SIZES**

Finished Circumference About 19 1/2 in. (49.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

# **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® MANDALA® OMBRE (Art. #551)
   #205 Tranquil 1 cake
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



#### ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)

#### **GAUGE**

1 Granny Square = about 3 1/4 in. (8.5 cm) square. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### **NOTES**

- 1. 6 Granny Squares are worked separately, then joined together to form a ring.
- 2. Brim is worked directly onto one edge of the ring and top of Hat is worked directly onto opposite edge of ring.
- 3. Brim and top of Hat are worked in continuous rnds (spiral).

# **GRANNY SQUARES** (make 6)

Ch 4; sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have four 3-dc groups and 4 ch-2 sps in this rnd.

Rnd 2: SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp (first corner made), (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in each of next 3 ch-2 sps; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 – Eight 3-dc groups and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Two 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Rnd 3: SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, \* 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups; join with sI st in top of beg ch-3 – Twelve 3-dc groups and 4 corner ch-2 sps (Three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

# Join Squares to make a ring

Match sts and corners along one side of 2 Granny Squares. From RS, working in back loops only of both Granny Squares, join yarn with sl st in corner at beg of edge, sl st in each st across edge to join the Granny Squares together.

Fasten off.

Rep to join all 6 Granny Squares into a strip. Then rep once more to join ends of strip to form make a ring. Note: If you prefer, you can sew the Squares into a ring.

# Top of Hat

**Rnd 1 (RS):** From RS, join yarn with sl st in any st along one edge of ring, work 66 sc evenly spaced along edge of ring (working 11 sc evenly spaced along edge of each Granny Square); do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – 66 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 3: \* Sc2tog, sc in next 9 sts; rep from \* around – 60 sts.

Rnd 4: Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 5:** \* Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from \* around – 50 sts.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: \* Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 40 sts.

Rnd 8: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 9: \* Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts: rep from \* around – 30 sts.

Rnd 10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: \* Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 20 sts.

Rnd 12: Sc in each st around.

**Rnds 13 and 14:** \* Sc2tog; rep from \* around – 5 sts in Rnd 14.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread tail through top of sts of last rnd and pull to close opening at top of Hat. Knot securely.

#### **Brim**

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join yarn with sl st in any st along unworked edge of ring, work 72 sc evenly spaced along edge of ring (working 12 sc evenly spaced along edge of each Granny Square); do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – 72 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2 and 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from \* around – 84 sts.

Rnd 5: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from \* around – 96 sts.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts; rep from \* around – 108 sts.

Rnd 8: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts; rep from \* around – 120 sts.

Rnds 9 and 10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: SI st in each st around.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

**ch** = chain

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

**dc** = double crochet

**rep** = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

**RS** = right side

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)



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
