

Willow Park Scarf



Pattern #-M23092 MDO

Lion Brand® Mandala® Ombre

SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 9 x 60 in. (23 x 152.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® MANDALA® OMBRE (Art. #551)
 #209 Balance 1 cake
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)

GAUGE

16 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern in Rows 1-6 of Main Section.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

k3pso (knit 3, pass stitch over) K3, use tip of left needle to lift the first of the 3 sts just knit over the other 2 knit sts and off right needle.

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then knit through back of same st – 1 st increased.

pfb (purl into front and back) Purl next st without removing it from left needle, then p through back of same st – 1 st increased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. Scarf is worked diagonally from corner to corner, in 3 sections: Increase Section, Main Section, and Decrease Section.
- 2. Increases are worked at beg of every row of Increase Section. Increases are worked at beg of odd-numbered rows and decreases are worked at beg of even-numbered rows of Main Section. Decreases are worked at beg of every row of Decrease Section.

SCARF

Cast on 3 sts.

Increase Section

Row 1: Purl.

Row 2: K1, kfb, k1 – you will have 4 sts in this row.

Row 3: P1, pfb, p2 - 5 sts.

Row 4: K1, kfb, k3 – 6 sts.

Row 5: P1, pfb, p4 - 7 sts.

Row 6: K1, kfb, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2 – 8 sts.

Row 7: P1, pfb, p to end of row -9 sts.

Row 8: K1, kfb, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 10 sts.

Row 9: P1, pfb, p to end of row -11 sts.

Row 10: K1, kfb, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3 – 12 sts.

Rows 11-40: Rep Rows 5-10 for 5 more times – 42 sts in Row 40.

Main Section

Row 1: P1, pfb, p to end of row -43 sts.

Row 2: K1, k2tog, k2, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2 – 42 sts.

Row 3: P1, pfb, p to end of row -43 sts.

Row 4: K1, k2tog, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 42 sts.

Row 5: P1, pfb, p to end of row -43 sts.

Row 6: K1, k2tog, k1, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3 – 42 sts.

Rep Rows 1-6 until piece measures about 60 in. (152.5 cm) along the longest edge, end with a Row 6 as the last row you work.

Decrease Section

Row 1: P1, p2tog, p to end of row – 41 sts.

Row 2: K1, k2tog, k2, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3 – 40 sts.

Row 3: P1, p2tog, p to end of row -39 sts.

Row 4: K1, k2tog, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3 – 38 sts.

Row 5: P1, p2tog, p to end of row -37 sts.

Row 6: K1, k2tog, k1, * yo, k3pso; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3 – 36 sts.

Rows 7-30: Rep Rows 1-6 for 4 more times – 12 sts in Row 30.

Rows 31 and 32: Rep Rows 1 and 2 - 10 sts.

Row 33: P1, p2tog, p to end of row -9 sts.

Row 34: K1, k2tog, k to end of row -8 sts.

Rows 35-40: Rep Rows 33 and 34 for 3 more times – 2 sts in Row 40.

Row 41: P2tog – 1 st.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

 $\mathbf{k} = \text{knit}$

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)
